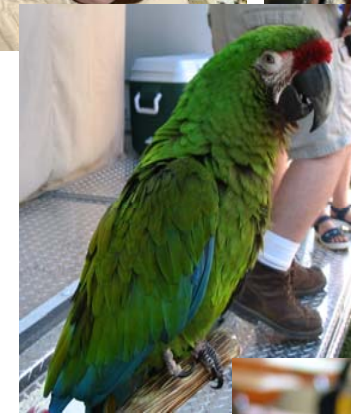

Creepy Critters Can Be Cool!

Most animals are not cute and cuddly, but rather creepy. We will discuss some of the creepiest: arachnids, insects, amphibians and reptiles. People often confuse spiders and bugs or reptiles and amphibians. Our goal is to straighten out the confusion and have some fun. We will introduce your students to our animals and hope that they find creepy critters can be cool not scary!

Tropical Rainforest: A Circle of Life

This show discusses how everything in an ecosystem is linked. Plants and animals do not live in isolation but are small members of a much larger environment. Species rely on one another to provide food and habitat needs. Some of the concepts explored are photosynthesis, food chain/web and habitats.

Animal Tales

This program is especially appropriate for the younger kids, pre-k through 1st grade. Age-appropriate stories will be read. After each story, the animal featured in the story will be introduced to the children. They will then have the opportunity to learn about and even touch the animals!

Wetlands: More than Just Swamps

Vanishing wetlands is an ongoing problem throughout the world today. Find out why wetlands are such an important water filter and the kinds of animals that thrive in this biome.

Each program is designed to make learning fun and safe for everyone. A nine foot video screen displays maps of the world, photographs of habitats for each animal and live video feeds to make the smaller animals larger than life! Programs are tailored to meet the requirements of each grade level and are accompanied by activities packets. Each show is 45 minutes. To be guaranteed a hands-on experience, each program should have 100 students or less. One to six shows can be scheduled each school day.
